**Moving on to Success** is a free employment training program with a priority to serve women who have experienced or are at risk of domestic violence. Moving on to Success helps women gain the skills and self esteem needed to begin achieving economic independence.

**Who can benefit from this program:**

Women who...

- Are survivors of abuse, in abusive situations or are at risk
- Want to enter the workforce
- Want to gain economic self-reliance and stability
- Want to explore career, training and education options
- Can commit to an employment action plan

**This program offers:**

- Career assessment and workshops
- Development of employability skills
- Access to employment preparation and training programs
- One-on-one support from counsellors and job developers
- Job coaching and mentoring
- Connections to supportive work environments such as on the job placements
- Résumé and interview preparation
- Ongoing support for up to one year

**Monday to Friday: 8:30 am - 4:30 pm**  
In order to participate in the program, women are invited to an assessment interview and are to submit a résumé.

Registration is ongoing.

**Eligible participants may apply for benefits and support such as child care, transportation and tuition.**
