Pre-Apprenticeship Carpentry Training Program for Women

*This **free** program prepares women for paid general carpentry apprenticeships.*

The 35 week program includes:

- 7 weeks of academic upgrading at Bongard House (80 Woodlawn Ave East)
- 3 weeks of job readiness and safety training at Bongard House (80 Woodlawn Ave East)
- 13 weeks of introductory training in general carpentry and residential A/C systems at George Brown College (146 Kendal Ave at Spadina Rd & Davenport Ave)
- A paid twelve-week work placement after the formal training program is completed
