WHMIS training is legally required for all employees in contact with hazardous material at the workplace. Industries that may require WHMIS include health and social service, retail, manufacturing, industrial, and agriculture. JUMP Etobicoke is offering the online WHMIS 2015 training, developed by Workplace Safety & Prevention Services (WSPS), a major industrial leader in Ontario.

We will review the steps to complete the training at your own pace and a code will be provided to access the training. Upon completing the course and successfully passing the exam, you will receive the WHMIS 2015 Certificate.

During the training you will learn to:

- Recognize the WHMIS symbols and their meaning
- Understand Safety Data Sheets (SDS) and workplace labels
- Take measures to protect yourself with hazardous material
