WHAT IS YWCA TORONTO'S GIRLS' CENTRE?

YWCA Toronto Girls' Centre is a girls-only space. At the Girls' Centre, girls 9 to 18 years of age try new activities, develop skills and discuss topics in a safe place. Girls build leadership skills, enhance their self-esteem, learn to live safely in their communities, make new friends and learn to understand and challenge the world around them. Girls and young women can also receive support on difficult issues, share ideas, express creativity, explore interests and plan their futures. And they have a lot of fun!

WHAT IS THE GIRLS' TALK MENTORSHIP PROGRAM?

The YWCA Toronto Girls' Talk Mentorship Program is a yearlong mentorship opportunity for young women 16 years and up, who want to be positive role models for younger girls. In this program, mentors and mentees meet weekly throughout the school year, exploring different topics that build self-confidence and empowerment, develop skills. and assist in healthy decisionmaking. Through this experience, mentors gain leadership experience and can acquire volunteer hours. In order to apply to be a mentor in the Girls' Talk Mentorship Program, you must participate in the Girls' Talk Leadership Summer Camp.

WHAT IS THE GIRLS' TALK LEADERSHIP CAMP?

Summer Camp is a free, weeklong summer camp for girls 16 and up who are interested in applying to be mentors in our Girls' Talk

Mentorship Program. This camp offers young women fun ways to develop their leadership skills, and prepares them to be healthy, positive role models for younger girls in their communities. Girls who complete this Leadership Camp are eligible to apply to be mentors in the Girls' Centre's

Girls' Talk Mentorship Program.
