RETAIL TRAINING CERTIFICATE AND JOB SEARCH PROGRAM

- Training includes: customer service and cash register training
- Learn to prepare your résumé and find jobs in the retail industry
- Receive a certificate upon completion of all workshops

FOOD HANDLING CERTIFICATE AND JOB SEARCH PROGRAM

- Learn important information about food safety
- Learn how to prevent food-borne illnesses
- Prepare to work in the food or restaurant industry
- Take an exam through the Ministry of Health which is valid for 5 years

BASIC CASH REGISTER TRAINING

- Learn how to process sales, discounts, and return items
- Participate in role-plays and practice your customer service skills
- Add this experience to your résumé

PUBLIC SPEAKING TRAINING SERIES

- Gain confidence and practice speaking English
- Overcome fears of public speaking
- Learn techniques to develop stronger presentation skills

ENTREPRENEURIAL SKILLS FOR HOME BASED BUSINESS CERTIFICATE TRAINING

- Learn the basic steps for creating a business
